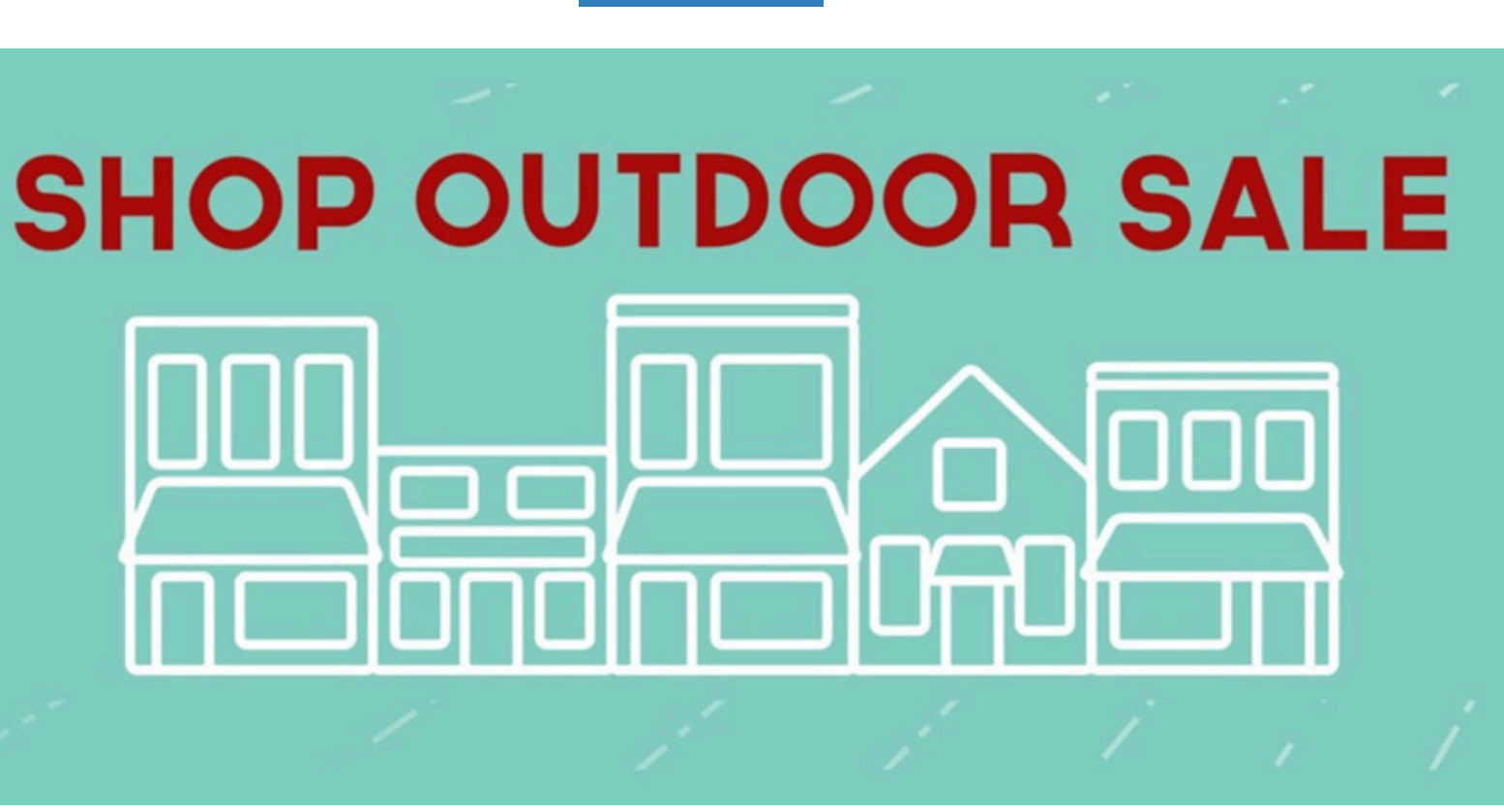


Oak Park's July 4th parade 2025!
